Such persons would be given deputation terms upto the date on which they are due for release from the Armed Forces, thereafter they may be considered on re-employment.

2. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding 50 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications. Preference will be given to those with certificate of diploma in the trade from recognised Institute. The departmental officers in the lesser category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment by deputation. Similarly, constables shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

3. The period of deputation in the BSF Engineering Set-up including the period of deputation in other ex-schedule post held immediately preceding this appointment or the same or some other Organization or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

4. During the period of deputation, the candidates selected for these posts shall be governed by the provisions contained in DOP&T OM No. 58/2009-Est/R/RR dated 17.06.2010 and MVA (Police & Divisional LNs. 1-2132/202/2216-Pers-4 dated 22.11.2015 as amended from time to time. Appointees on deputation does not entitle them to claim seniority, pay and allowances or any other pecuniary or service benefits over others and their seniority will continue to be reckoned in their original cadre/department for all purposes including promotion, financial up-gradation, etc. Furthermore, they do not have any interest/rights to direct absorption, as the deputation is about them independently with the BSF.

5. As and when a situation arises for promotion/re-investigation/re-appointment to the previous cadre of the appointments due to unsatisfactory, incomplete, inadequacy of service or any other unforeseen factors, his/her services could be restored after giving an advance notice of three months to the leading Service/Department and the employee concerned.

6. As these posts are required to be filled up urgently, nomination of eligible/willing candidates may be forwarded in the given proforma along with duly attested copy of CR documents/PAUs of the last five years to the Deputy Inspector General (Staff), Directorate General, BSF, Block No. 4, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi - 110003. The last date for receipt of nominations will be the 80th day from the date of publication of this advertisement in the Employment News.

7. All the posts are gazetted posts and the concerned candidates are requested to submit original of the documents which they have submitted. The concerned candidates are advised not to forward any original documents or certificates along with their application forms. It may also be confirmed that in the event of selection for appointment, the candidate concerned will be relieved of these duties. Additionally, instructions contained in MVA (Police & Div/letter number 1/2102/202/2216-Pers-4 dated 22.11.2010 may be observed while forwarding nominations.

8. The crucial date for determining eligibility will be the last date prescribed for receipt of nominations, in accordance with DOP&T OM No. A3-14017/1/1999-Est/RR dated 03.10.1999.
